Like the Spinnerei in Leipzig, a former industrial complex has been brought back to life in Nuremberg; “Auf AEG” has an area of 30,000m². It is an initiative of a group of financiers who have recognised the special

qualities of this particular geographic location and have attracted innovative businesses, cultural establishments and artists to the area.

The dynamic improvement to this western part of Nuremberg is reinforced by regularly inviting the local residents for guided tours, exhibitions, performances or celebrations. In the weekend of 24th -25th September we were invited as guest gallery to take part in the grand cultural opening. Our gallery presented the work of **Christiane Baumgartner** and **Paul Heimbach** in the large exhibition hall 20, where other galleries from de Spinnerei including Eigen+ Art and Dogenhaus were also exhibiting. This was a perfect space to show the magnificent monumental works of Baumgartner. Paul Heimbach's *Farbskala in drei Farben auf zwei Ebenen* (520 x 175 cm) an installation consisting of 64 drawings, was shown here for the first time on a single wall.
